11. Public Utility Easement Agreement - Added

13. Partial Pay Request – Added

<u>MOTION</u> by Comm Taylor, seconded by Comm Goodwill to approve the partial payment request in the amount of \$1,224,450.12 submitted for October 1 through December 31, 2016 for the jail construction and related expenses.

Board members were provided a copy of the billing from Granger and two from Hooker DeJong for their review.

14. Commissioners Training Discussion – Added

Adm. Jordan explained that periodically legal counsel for the County sets up a meeting to discuss their duties, responsibility, and miscellaneous statutes. After some discussion, Board members agreed to schedule the meeting for January 27<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m. at the ISD.

15. Discussion on getting an appraisal on the Jail/Sheriff's Department building - Added

A commissioner thought it would be a good idea to get an appraisal on the old Sheriff's Department and look at selling the property after the new facility has been completed. He would like to see the building sold or used as an overflow for prisoners and storage for the County. Adm. Jordan explained that the Sheriff's Department is full of asbestos and it would be very costly to remove it so the building could be sold or used for something different. The topic will be taken to the Building and Recreation Committee for further discussion.

### Administrator's Report

Board members were provided with a written report from Adm. Jordan. He informed the Board that the HSA debit cards are coming out now and the insurance card will be received by the employees within a couple of weeks.
