9. Health Insurance HSA - Added

MOTION by Comm Nichols, seconded by Comm Taylor to move to amend the Wexford County Health Savings Account on a monthly, quarterly, or annual basis. The employer's Annual Contribution to the Health Savings Account shall be credited or deposited to each participating employee's Health Savings Account in four equal prorata quarterly deposits on the first business day of each quarter, beginning January 2, 2019, April 1, 2019, July 1, 2-10 and October 1, 2019.

MOTION by Comm Nichols, seconded by Comm Taylor to ratify the terms of the Tentative Agreement reached in the TPOAM Supervisors Unit on November 28, 2018 and direct the Board Chair to executive the 2019-2021 Agreement when it is produced by the County's Corporation Counsel.

MOTION by Comm Nichols, seconded by Comm Taylor to ratify the terms of the Tentative Agreement reached in the TPOAM Courthouse/General /Circuit Court Unit on November 28, 2018 and direct the Board Chair to execute the 2019-2021 Agreement when it is produced by the County's Corporation Counsel.

MOTION by Comm Nichols, seconded by Comm Taylor to ratify the terms of the Tentative Agreement reached in the POAM Corrections Unit on November 29, 2018 and direct the Board Chair to execute the 2019-2021 Agreement as produced by the County's Corporation Counsel

Roll call: Motion approved unanimously.

MOTION by Comm Nichols, seconded by Comm Bengelink to implement the same base wage increases on the wage scales for 2019, 2020 and 2021 for Wexford County Non-Union and Appointed Employees effective January 1, 2019 and to amend the 2019 Budget as necessary; and to implement the same vacation maximum accumulation and maximum pay-out amounts for Wexford County Non-Union and appointed employees; to implement the same MERS Defined Benefit Plan Employees Contributions and Hybrid Plan Employer Minimum Contributions to the Defined Contribution Plans, being 5% to be effective January 1, 2019 and further direct the County Clerk to contact MERS to secure the necessary MERS Motions/Resolution to effectuate such changes.

11. Resolution 18-38 to Implement the Public Act 152 Health Care Requirements for 2019 – *Added* 

MOTION by Comm Taylor, seconded by Comm Bengelink to move that the Wexford County Board of Commissioners elect to impose Employer Contribution limits known as hard caps, which results in an employee cost share of an amount equal to an employee j10% health insurance premium contribution to satisfy the funding limitation requirements of Public Act 152 of 2011 for Health Plan Year 2019.
