RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ELECTION FOR A WEXFORD COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL FUND MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL AND CERTIFYING BALLOT LANGUAGE

- WHEREAS, County Animal Control Services and the Wexford County Animal Shelter are of substantial benefit to the citizens of the County of Wexford; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Wexford deems it necessary and expedient for the County to operate and maintain Animal Control functions and the Wexford County Animal Shelter; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Wexford has determined that it is appropriate to submit a millage renewal proposition to the electors of the County at the next State Primary Election to be held in said County on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, to determine whether or not the electors desire to raise funds for the purpose of continued County Animal Control functions, and for an Animal shelter to be operated by the County, or by a public or non-profit contractor, in a manner that may help to facilitate in the care of the animals in a no kill environment; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the County of Wexford seeks to have the voters of said County determine whether or not they desire to continue to raise funds for these purposes through a renewal millage of 0.20 of one (1) mill for a period of six (6) years, 2024 through 2029, inclusive, being the same rate previously authorized by the voters in 2020 for the County Animal Control Program.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the following question be submitted to a vote of the electorate of Wexford County at the next State Primary Election to be held in said County on Tuesday, August 6, 2024.

COUNTY OF WEXFORD PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE RENEWAL FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES PROPOSAL

- WHEREAS, County law enforcement services are of substantial benefit to the citizens of the County of Wexford; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Wexford deems it necessary and expedient for the County to operate and maintain public safety law enforcement functions; and
- WHEREAS, county-wide Sheriff's Office public safety millages were authorized by the voters in 2001, 2006, 2010, 2012 and 2018 and continued levy of a tax to support public safety law enforcement services in 2024, and thereafter, requires voter re-authorization; and
- **WHEREAS**, 1.45 mills will be required in order to adequately provide Sheriff's Office public safety law enforcement services; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Wexford seeks to have the voters of said County determine whether or not they desire to continue to raise funds for the purpose of supporting the provision and improvement of County Sheriff's Office public safety law enforcement services by renewing the approved millage 1.45 mills for a period of six (6) years, 2024 through 2029, inclusive.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the following proposal be submitted to the qualified voters of the County of Wexford at the next State Primary Election to be held in said County on Tuesday, August 6, 2024:

COUNTY OF WEXFORD PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE RENEWAL FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES PROPOSAL

For the purpose of funding the law enforcement fund to subsidize the continued operation of the County Sheriff's Office public safety law enforcement services, shall the constitutional limitation on general ad valorem taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Wexford, Michigan be renewed, and shall the County be authorized to levy, up to 1.4500 mills (\$1.45 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of six (6) years (2024-2029), inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this Millage will raise an estimated \$1,746,188 for County Sheriff's Office public safety law enforcement services within Wexford County in the first calendar year of the levy based on state taxable valuation. In accordance with state law, a small portion of the millage raised may be disbursed to the City of Cadillac Downtown Development, Local Development Finance and the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MILLAGE ELECTION FOR THE COUNTY VETERANS SERVICES PROGRAM RENEWAL OF MILLAGE PROPOSAL AND CERTIFYING BALLOT LANGUAGE

- WHEREAS, the voters of Wexford County supported a 0.10 mill tax to fund veteran services within Wexford County in 2014 and 2018, which millage provided authorization through the 2023 tax levy, and continued levy of a tax in 2024, and thereafter, requires voter re-authorization; and
- WHEREAS, Act 214 of the Public Acts of 1899, Act 77 of the Public Acts of 1945, and Act 192 of the Public Acts of 1953, being MCL 35.21, 35.11, and 35.621, authorizes the Board of Commissioners for the County of Wexford to levy taxes and appropriate funds for the purpose of providing services to veterans and for the purpose of providing relief of honorably discharged indigent veterans and their indigent dependents; and
- WHEREAS, the millage is necessary to maintain County veterans affairs program dedicated to providing services to Wexford County veterans of active United States military service and their dependents; and
- **WHEREAS**, County veterans services program is of substantial benefit to the citizens of the County of Wexford; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the County of Wexford seeks to have the voters of the County determine whether or not they desire to raise funds for the purpose of providing veterans' services at the same level of millage previously approved in 2018, by approving a millage renewal of 0.1000 of one (1) mill for a period of six (6) years, 2024 through 2029, inclusive.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the following proposal be submitted to the qualified voters of the County of Wexford at the next State Primary Election to be held in said County on Tuesday, August 6, 2024:

COUNTY OF WEXFORD COUNTY VETERANS SERVICES PROGRAM PROPOSAL RENEWAL

For the purpose of funding a County veterans affairs program to provide services to Wexford County veterans of active United States military service and their dependents, including providing funding for the County Department of Veterans' Services and the statutorily provided assistance to indigent veterans and their dependents within Wexford County, shall the constitutional limitation on general ad valorem taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Wexford, Michigan be renewed, and shall the County be authorized to levy, up to 0.1000 of one (1) mill (\$0.10 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of six (6) years (2024-2029), inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this Millage will raise an estimated additional \$120,245 for veteran services within Wexford County in the first calendar year of the levy based on state taxable valuation. In accordance with state law, a small portion of the millage raised may be disbursed to the City of Cadillac Downtown Development, Local Development Finance and Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities

To purchase a transport vehicle for preferably the 20 2 4 Explorer 17-year-old qualified youth under the Raise the Age Grant. To purchase a safety cage with plexiglass

Financial Information (note the total cost, if the cost is budgeted, if there will be any future costs, e.g., maintenance contracts, and any other information that would assist the commissioners with this decision:)

The MI Deal purchase price is \$46, 420.00.

Cage/ Plexiglass \$2500.00

The funds have been applied for and approved under the Raise the Age Grant. The line item was requested and approved for reimbursed up to 50,000 dollars.

There will be future costs for a safety cage with a plexiglass. The raise the age line item currently has a reimbursement up to 2500.00 dollars.

Summary (explain why the action is necessary and the desired outcome after implementation:

The vehicle is needed for transportation of older qualified youth. Facility availability in Michigan for residential and detention placement has become a big challenge. We are forced to go on longer transports, even out of state in most cases.

Timeline (if request is approved at BOC meeting date noted above):

The vehicle will be available 29 days. The cage will be purchased and addressed after we receive the vehicle.
