Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Greenwood Township, of One mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to .9749 mills (97.49 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and restored up to the original voted 1.00 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for Four years, 2026 through 2029 inclusive, for fire protection and the operation of the Colfax-Greenwood Fire Department raising an estimated \$31,493.00

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MILLAGE BALLOT LANGUAGE

Greenwood Township, Wexford County Resolution # 001-2026

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Greenwood wishes to provide fire protection and operation of the Colfax-Greenwood Fire Department from 2026 thru 2029.

WHEREAS, townships may provide fire protection as authorized by Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution; and

WHEREAS, townships may contract and cooperate with other entities to provide fire protection, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and)

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Greenwood wishes to levy one mill to provide fire protection and operation of the Colfax-Greenwood Fire Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Greenwood, Wexford County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 4, 2026 election ballot:
